THIS MONTH'S THEME IS 'WHAT DO WE CELEBRATE'

Our learning through play will continue to progress well throughout our monthly activities. The children will continue to build on new skills daily please encourage these at home. This month our theme is 'What do we celebrate'. We will be talking about Christmas and how exciting it is and why we are celebrating. We will be talking about Santa & his little elf helpers and what presents we would like Santa to bring.

NUMBERS

Each day we encourage the children with recognition of numbers. Please encourage your children to count with you, discuss how many they count e.g. how many different shape & sizes of Christmas decorations, how reindeer Santa has, how many baubles on the Christmas tree etc.

THIS MONTH'S COLOURS - RED and GOLD

Our sand tray's will be filled with sand adding in baubles, glitter, tinsel, bows and Christmas decorations.

Our water will also be a mix of Christmassy colours with glitter, Christmas decorations, moulds and tinsel.

We will also be playing with shaving foam, 'snow' & Christmas decorations in our individual tray's.

Our tuff tray will be a North Pole scene.

THIS MONTH'S ARTS (we will send home children's work for you to display)

We will be using lots of different art & crafts to decorate pictures for our theme. E.g. crayons, felt tips, painting, sticking, junk art, footprints, tissue paper, making pictures using glue & sand.

We will be making:

Fingerprint Christmas trees, melted snowmen, Rudolph handprints, Grinch handprints, Christmas Snowflakes, brush stamping Christmas wreaths, Christmas cards, presents, reindeers & Olaf and gluing and sticking pictures.

Within the Toddlers room we will use "Circle Time" to read stories, poems etc to develop each child's love of books and language and knowledge.
